**Constitution of Udyog Mitra
Committee.**

GOVERNMENT OF MAHARASHTRA

Resolution No. UDM-1079/(2148)/IND-14.
Mantralaya, Bombay-400 032, Dated the 1st March 1984.

PREAMBLE:- With a view to achieving proper co-ordination in issue of requisite sanctions/clearances speedily to new units coming up in the backward areas in the State, State Government vide its resolution No. UDM-1079/9428/(2148)/IND-14, dated 21st November 1979, constituted High Power Co-ordination Committee popularly known as Udyog Mitra. The organisation of Udyog Mitra consists of two distinct parts viz. High Power Co-ordination Committee and its operational arm of the officers drawn from the various Departments concerned. The task of High Power Co-ordination Committee is two-fold. Firstly the High Power Co-ordination Committee is expected to find out solutions to general problems faced by industrialists having policy implications. At times, it might mean reconciliation of diverse objectives of different departments within overall framework of industrial policy of State Government. Secondly, it is necessary to persuade important projects by keeping close liaison with Heads of Department. The operational arm of High Power Co-ordination Committee viz. Udyog Mitra consists of junior officers, and hence has inherent limitations in bringing about effective co-ordination to subservise these objectives. During last few years the organisation has been playing increasingly significant role as prospective industrialists are relying on its support to their projects. With ever-widening role of Udyog-Mitra and increasing complexity of problems in securing necessary sanctions and clearances, a need has been felt for high level official committee for studying in depth general problems involved in co-ordination, pursuing vigorously sanctions and clearances to important industrial projects with the heads of the department concerned and generally implementing the industrial policy of Government in a coordinated manner.

RESOLUTION:- Government is accordingly pleased to constitute a High Level Official Committee with the following composition :-
